



Dear Parents,

Due to an overwhelmingly positive response to our interest in offering 30 hours nursery provision at Chinley Primary School Nursery the governors have taken the decision to introduce extended days for nursery children from September 2019.

Nursery sessions will be your choice of one of the following...

Option 1: 9:00am – 12:00pm (including snack but excluding lunch)

Option 2: 9:00am – 1:00pm (including snacks and lunch)

Option 3: 12:00pm – 3:00pm (including lunch and snacks)

Option 4: 9:00am – 3:00pm (including snacks and lunch)

Extended provision will be supplied by our Early Bird and Night Owl Club (EBNOC) which operates from 7:30am -9:00am and 3:00pm – 6:15 pm Monday to Thursday and 3:00pm – 5:15pm on Friday.

All 3 and 4 year olds are entitled to 15 hours free nursery provision each week, some children are eligible for 30 free nursery hours each week and some parents will want their children to be looked after for longer than their provision allows. We will be charging £4:00 per hour for provision beyond that to which your child is entitled.

It is of course still possible to split your entitlement between one or more providers which means you may want your child to attend Chinley Primary School Nursery and somewhere else. This is absolutely fine but we will ask you to confirm your sessions for a whole half term at a time in order that we put the appropriate number of staff in place.

Our intake dates for the 2019-2020 school year are September 4th 2019, January 6th 2020 and April 20th 2020. If your child is 3 on or before any of these dates they will be able to join our nursery that term. We have a limited number of places available and so if you wish to secure a nursery place for your child please complete the form below and return to the school office as soon as possible.

As a school we open during term times only, at present we have no provision for holiday sessions. Also it is important to remind you that a place at Chinley School Nursery does not automatically entitle your child to a place in reception class. You must apply for this, as all parents do, via the DCC website.

Our extended provision offer and the relevant costs are attached to help you plan your child's time at Chinley School Nursery and see the potential costs to yourselves.
