SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY AND EXPECTATIONS

INTRODUCTION

At Chinley School we understand that children should dress appropriately for the weather and the activities taking place which can sometimes mean variations from the stated expectation below. Governors are committed to ensuring that uniform expectations are reasonable and do not over-stretch family finances. There are a large number of pre-loved uniform items which are available at no cost or for a donation provided by the PTA which all families have access to.

CLOTHING

All children have their own coat peg. All personal clothing should be clearly marked, particularly items like sweatshirts, coats and wellingtons. Unfortunately, personal items do occasionally go astray. Parents are requested to check the lost property basket at the school entrance as soon as possible if this happens. Any valuable lost property is stored at the school office.

UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

The Governors expect all children to comply with the recommended dress code as detailed below:

Winter

- Red or navy sweatshirt (Chinley School logo if preferred – **not expected**), with navy or white polo shirt or shirt underneath. Navy/grey/black plain trousers, skirt or pinafore dress.
- Sensible black shoes. No platforms, high heels or coloured trainers.

Summer

- Polo shirt in navy or white
- Trousers/skirt as for winter or navy/grey/black shorts
- Red or Navy Gingham dress if preferred
- Sensible black shoes. No platforms, high heels or coloured trainers.

P.E.

- All children come to school dressed for P.E. on P.E. days.
- Pumps for indoor activities and trainers for outdoor games.
- Long hair tied back for all PE activities.
- Earrings removed or taped over with micropore tape (supplied by parents).
- Please name all items of clothing.
- Parents are encouraged to provide a T-shirt in the child's house team colour for P. E. activities. The children are members of a house team – South Head; Cracken; Kinder or Eccles and they work together towards rewards for their house team.
- No sports team shirts to be worn.
