Early Years Outcomes

83% of children in our Reception Class (29 children) reached a good level of development (the expected level for children leaving Early Years).

Year 1 Phonics Check

All children take a national assessment in Year 1 to assess their phonic ability **97%** (29 children) passed the check.

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

Average score **19.5**; % of pupils with full marks **18.8%** (32 children)
