Early Years Outcomes

76.7% of children in our Reception Class (30 children) reached a good level of development (the expected level for children leaving Early Years).

Year 1 Phonics Check

All children take a national assessment in Year 1 to assess their phonic ability **95.5%** (30 children) passed the check.

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

Average score **20.1** and % pupils with full marks **18.2%** (33 children)
